A lot has happened to the Playhouse since our last production. Through the generosity of a major benefactor, we have been able to accomplish a substantial amount of work on the building. The most evident to you is the addition of a new central heating and air conditioning system. Not so obvious, but important to those

of us on stage and in the wings, is the beginnings of a new stage lighting system. Not only will you be able to enjoy the show in cool comfort but you will be able to see what happens on stage much better. In addition, the summer break gave us time to remove the old ceiling tiles, install a new ceiling with proper insulation and two more seating tiers.

Immediate future plans call for a new roof and the renovation of the marquee. These changes are made possible through a matching grant from the Office for Historical Preservation. Matching funds of approximately \$17,000 are needed for this project. Your support is always appreciated.
