Directors Notes

James Barrie, the author of Peter Pan, never had any children of his own, but he spent a lot of time playing with the children of two of his friends, Sylvia and Llewelyn Davies. The Davies died of cancer within the same year and James Barrie adopted all five of their children. The play Peter Pan started out as skits acted out for and with the Davies children. Barrie's script was originally rejected because it was so elaborate. In 1904 plays did not generally involve such frequent and major scene changes and there was no flying! These are the same challenges that faced our production team. How to create the magic of Neverland, and include the technical challenge of flight, while singing, dancing, and fighting has become one of our biggest adventures!

We are fortunate to have "Fly by Foy" overseeing the flying mechanisms and flying of our actors. Peter Foy, the founder of the company, invented the machinery that has flown such popular Peter Pans as Sandy Duncan and Cathy Rigby.

Peter Pan is a magical story of never wanting to grow up of staying a child forever... wouldn't that be lovely! We miss those care-free days of childhood filled with one adventure after another. Our awesome cast and crew have worked very hard to create a visual adventure that for a few hours will help you remember your childhood adventures and maybe... just maybe... you'll see the world through a child's eyes, look at each moment as a new adventure, and never grow up enough to forget how to play! The cast and crew have reminded us of that as well in the need for a balance of hard work with healthy doses of encouragement and fun!

We'll see you in Neverland... second star to the right and straight on til morning.

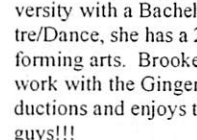

Musical Theatre of the State of Georgia by the Georgia Legislature.



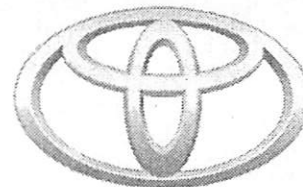

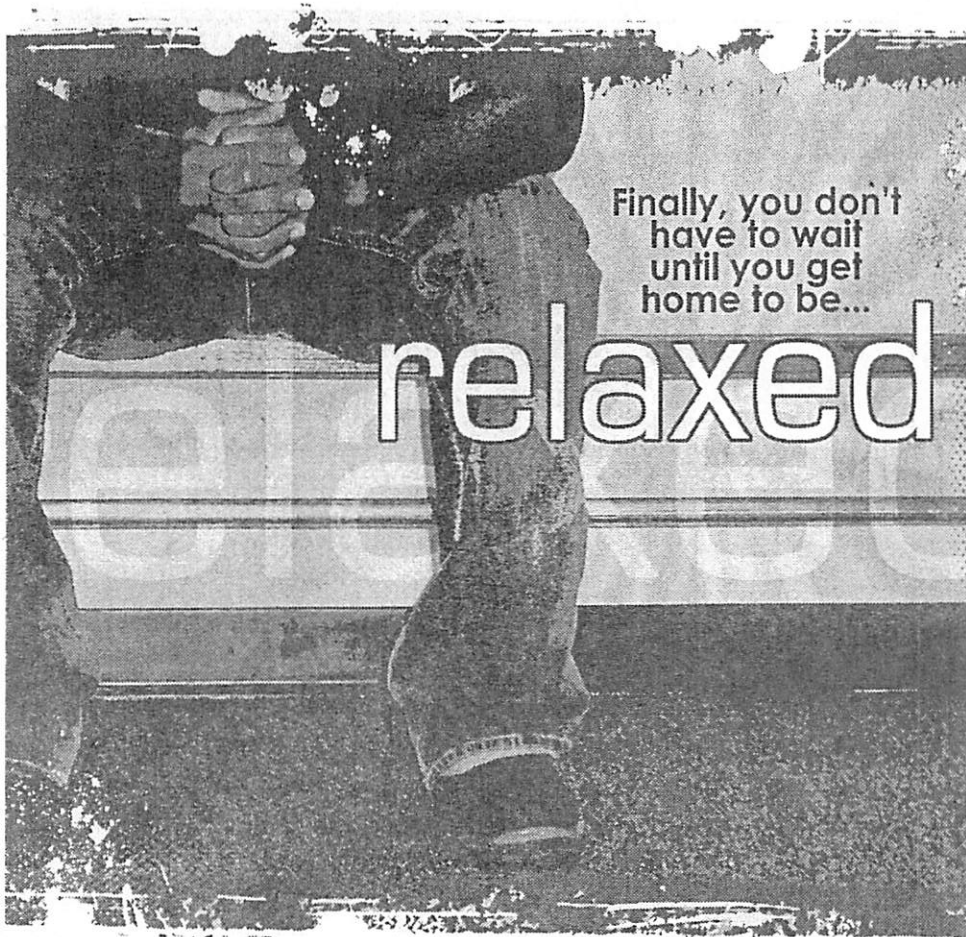

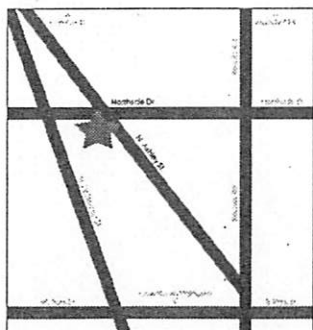

History

TGV was organized in 1989 through the efforts of the Lowndes/Valdosta Arts Commission as an autonomous community theater group with non-profit tax-exempt status. After three years as a group of vagabond players with no home, the group purchased the old 'Dosta Theatre building in 1992 and set about converting the dilapidated movie theatre into a playhouse for live stage performances. Thanks to many supporters and one large benefactor, TGV now owns three adjoining buildings in historic downtown Valdosta. The all-volunteer group produces four main stage shows and two children's shows each year. All of this is done in order to provide a high quality theater experience for our community.
