CAST NOTES

Sandra Dickson ("Ouiser") received her Bachelor's degree in theatre from Valdosta State College and her PhD from Georgia State University. She is currently Curriculum Director for the Lowndes County School System. Sandra has been involved in theatre for over 25 years and has worked with numerous educational and community theatres throughout Georgia. She has appeared as "Amanda" in Glass Menagerie, "Mrs. Gibbs" in Our Town, "Lady Brockhurst" in The Boyfriend, and "Jane Seymour" in Royal Gambit to name only a few. She has also directed many shows, including last season's successful Arsenic and Old Lace and also serves as Secretary for TGV. Sandra is currently busy directing Winnie the Pooh, TGV's Children's show opening April 8.

Kathleen Dixon ("Annelle") is a graduate of Lowndes High School. She is currently a Communications Arts major at Valdosta State University. Her first experience with Theatre Guild was in this season's hilarious <u>Run</u> For Your Wife.

Kathleen Getman ("M'Lynn") was introduced to the Valdosta audience in Oliver. She had previously been involved in several productions with the Albany Little Theatre highlighted by having the lead in <u>Cabaret</u>.
